Located where its supplies are sourced, OvinAlp perpetuates a tradition that dates back several millennia (the use of migon, sheep manure from the Alps from extensive cattle raising) to enrich soil effectively and promote natural, balanced and efficient crop-growing methods.

Today, OvinAlp, a company born from tradition, with an ultra-modern production unit and a fruitful Research & Innovation centre, recommends and develops fertiliser solutions for very demanding professionals who are accredited for organic agriculture and biodynamics. Ov is the active principle of OvinAlp, obtained from the solid biofermentation of organic plant matter from high-quality sheep manure through the action of particularly rich and naturally present microbial flora.

Standardisation and certification

As the first company with ISO 14001 certification for its composting process and platform, OvinAlp's sustainable development strategy aims to improve the fertility of cultivated soils and plant nutrition, with respect for the environment, users and consumers.
